Grand Tinel's 2009 Chateauneuf du Pape, which comes from two fabulous sectors, La Gardiole and Palestor, is composed of 80% Grenache, 15% Syrah and 5% Mourvedre, all aged in foudre, concrete tanks, stainless steel and small, old barrels. The wine reveals lots of unsmoked tobacco leaf intermixed with red and black currants, cherries, garrigue and earth. It is an elegant, fresh, medium-bodied Chateauneuf to drink over the next 5-7 years. (Not yet released) Importers: various American importers including: J & R Selections, Lansing, MI; tel.
