Bright purple. Vivid, high-pitched red and dark berries on the nose, complemented by an alluring array of floral and spice qualities. Pure, focused and sweet, with dense but lively black raspberry and boysenberry flavors and a firm mineral spine. The finish leaves smoke and floral notes behind, along with a hint of white pepper. This wine is made up 70% grenache, 15% cinsault, 14% syrah and 1% mourvedre, and none of the fruit is destemmed **91-93 points**

(70% grenache, 15% cinsault, 14% syrah and 1% mourvedre, all raised in *foudres*): Deep ruby. Intense aromas of black raspberry, mulberry and violet, with an exotic note of apricot and slow-mounting spiciness. Stains the palate with vibrant, seamless red and dark berry preserve flavors. Smoothly blends richness and vivacity and finishes with excellent cut and spicy persistence. **92 points**
