

2010 Henri Sorrel Hermitage les Rocoules

Even more oily, the 2010 Hermitage Les Rocoules Blanc tips the scales at 14.8% natural alcohol. Made from 60-year-old vines, there are only 125 cases of this blend of 90% Marsanne and 10% Roussanne. Thick, juicy notes of quince, creme brulee, nut oil, crushed rock and white currants emerge from this full-bodied white along with good acidity and no evidence of oak.
