Kicking off the 2012s, the Châteauneuf du Pape Prestige, which is 95% Grenache and 5% Syrah, has beautiful kirsch, strawberry, dried flowers and licorice aromas and flavors, medium to full-bodied richness, and an elegant, seamless feel. This is a hedonistic, yet balanced and graceful Châteauneuf to drink over the coming 7-8 years. An estate that continues to ratchet up the quality level, Domaine Jean Royer is run by the gregarious and talented Jean-Marie Royer, with help from the ever-present oenologist, Philippe Cambie. These wines excel for the sweet fruit, silky textures and overall seamless, balanced profile. I suspect they'll age reasonably well, but they drink beautifully in their youth. Similar to the 2011, with a touch more dark berry fruit and toast, the 2012 Chateauneuf du Pape Prestige (95% Grenache aged two-thirds in barrel and one-third in tank) is medium to full-bodied, sweetly fruited and has an elegant, seamless profile as well as knockout length on the finish. It should have a couple more years of drinkability over the traditional cuvee. Drink 2014-2023. This tiny estate is run by the talented Jean-Marie Royer, with consulting help from Philippe Cambie. The estate covers 10

acres, primarily in the southern part of the appellation, and the wines are Grenache-dominated, with transparent colors, perfumed aromatics and silky textures.
