The straw yellow 2013 Pointe d’agrumes is a 100% Sauvignon from sandy loam soils and greets open-hearted with lovely fresh and aromatic flavors of gooseberries, blackcurrant, nettles, and fresh earthy aroma. The palate of this medium-bodied charmer is fruit intense, juicy and round, but also piquant and mineral. The finish reveals nice lime flavors and a slight salinity.
