Starting with the 2013 Crozes Hermitage Blanc, which was tasted from barrel, it's a blend of equal parts Marsanne and Roussanne aged in older barrels. It offers a tropical, honeyed and floral style to go with a medium-bodied, textured and balanced feel on the palate. It has good acidity and should drink nicely for 2-3 years, possibly longer. Located in tiny cellar in downtown Tain l'Hermitage, Marc Sorrel makes classic, old-school red and whites that are almost overflowing with character.
