Still not yet bottled, the 2014 Gigondas is a classic wine from this estate that offers medium-bodied richness, a supple, silky texture and the textbook, exotic bouquet of basil, green herbs, blackcurrants and blackberries. The blend is the normal 70% Grenache, 15% Cinsault, 14% Syrah and the rest Mourvèdre, and it's aged in a combination of old foudre and concrete tanks. This beauty will drink nicely through 2024.

While not for everyone, the wines from Domaine du Cayron offer singular, classic and downright Provencal characters that I absolutely love. While I enjoy them in their youth, they have the ability to evolve nicely for 10-12 years.
